The abstract, extended abstract, presentation, posters for the research must be prepared adhering to the guidelines mentioned subsequently and uploaded to through the Submission web portal – Global Conference for Multidisciplinary Research 2026 (GCMR). Please ensure that you carefully review and comply with our established policies prior to submitting any work.

1. Abstract

To take a look at a sample abstract, posted in the webpage under guideline tab. Word Count – 500
You must submit your Author Declaration form with Abstract & Extended Abstract submission

2. Extended Abstract

An extended abstract prepared according to the given format/ guidelines are required to be uploaded in

PDF for review purposes. However, as recommended by the reviewers, the authors will get an opportunity to publish their extended abstracts in upcoming Achievers International Campus GCMR conference book.

Word Count – 1500

3. After acceptance of the abstract or extended abstract

Once the abstract is accepted, you will be notified via email, gcmr@iaicampus.com Be prepared to submit the camera-ready version according to instruction sent to you with the acceptance email.

Make sure the submission is in MS Word .docx* or .doc* format.

Note: The Proceedings compilation team requires the .docx* (MS Word) documents to make corrections if necessary. For general guidelines, please turn over.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Authors are allowed to submit their work for either Oral Presentation or Poster Presentation.
- Oral and poster presentations will be held in parallel sessions categorized under the thematic areas mentioned in the website.
- Authors should upload abstracts through the submission button, leaving out the names of the authors and their affiliations in the word file, to make the reviewing process. However, author details must separately be added to the appropriate section of the submission page.
- Please note that abstracts bearing author details will be rejected.
- Authors should ensure to leave sufficient space in the Abstract to add author details such as the names and affiliations after the review process for the purposes of final submission. Research work presented elsewhere will not be considered.
- Authors should add author details after the abstract is accepted for publication (For the purposes of Camera Ready Copy).
- Abstracts will be rejected without any further consideration if there is evidence of plagiarism or AI usage.
- The Editorial Committee of GCMR recommends that all authors verify their abstracts beforehand, against plagiarism and AI.
- Please use formatting as mentioned in the GCMR website for Abstract preparation.
